Welcome to our inaugural Triple Farms Sheep Genetics ram sale.

Triple Farms Sheep Genetics is located 20 mins north of Taumarunui in Ongarue. The property consists of 270ha of steep hill country. We also have another block in Waimiha which is 470ha of rolling hill country.

In 2022 we started breeding our own Coopdale rams as we were struggling to find the right genetics to suit our commercial farming system and our breeding goals. Through doing this we discovered our passion for stud breeding.

In late 2023 the opportunity came up for us to purchase Ashgrove Genetics Coopworth and Sufutex stud from the Parson's family and Travis Pymm in Northland. This was an exciting opportunity for us and we are looking forward to continuing and building on the work that they have already done.

We are working hard within the flock on structural soundness and our low input traits; facial eczema, dags, worms and fly, as we are trying to minimise the cost and workload for our clients.



We are also working on increasing our numbers across the Coopworth and Suftex flocks so we have even more selection pressure which will allow us to push even harder towards our low input traits, without losing the maternal traits.

We have 34 Coopworths, 16 Coopdale and 28 Suftex 2-Tooth rams up for sale.

Our Coopworth flock is FE Gold, which we are very proud of. This year we tested 7 rams at 0.6 with four of them passing. This is our second year of testing our

Coopdales. This year we tested 5 rams at 0.35 and all of them passed.

Genetic Indexes and Abbreviations Explained

The indexes explained below are economic values, measured in cents. E.g. a ram with a NZMW index of 2500 is equivalent to 2500 cents or \$25. His progeny inherits half his genetics or \$12.50. If he has 100 progeny, he generates \$1250 for the farm business in that year compared with an average ram in 1995 with a zero index.

MATERNAL GENETIC INDEXES - COOPWORTH AND COOPDALES

NZMW New Zealand Maternal Worth. An industry standard index for dual purpose sheep based on reproduction, lamb survival, lamb growth and adult ewe size indexes.

NZMW + M New Zealand Maternal Worth as above but includes meat.

DPG Dual purpose lamb growth. A function of pre-weaning growth, ewe milking ability, post weaning growth and carcase weight.

DPCR Dual purpose capped reproduction. The economic value of more lambs per year, per 2-Tooth and older ewes. Based on number of lambs born (NLB). This is capped so extreme fertility is not rewarded.

DPA Dual purpose adult size. A function of an adult ewe liveweight BV (EWT). Heavier ewes are penalised as have greater feed demand.

DPW Dual purpose wool production. A function of fleece weights.

DPS Dual purpose lamb survival. A function of lamb vigour at birth and ewe mothering ability.

DPM Dual purpose meat. A function of meat yield measured through EMA scanning.

DPF Dual purpose internal parasite. Measured from faecal egg count (FEC) using Wormfec system.

DPD Dual purpose dag score. The propensity to carry dags – based on LDAG (lamb) and ADAG (adult) BVS.

DPBC Dual purpose body condition score.

BR/RR Birth rank/rear rank. Eg. 2/1 means born as a twin, reared as a single.



TERMINAL GENETIC INDEXES - SUFTEX

NZTW New Zealand Terminal Worth. An industry standard index for terminal sheep based on meat, growth and survival. It excludes maternal traits such as reproduction. Mothering ability and wool traits.

TSG Terminal lamb growth. A function of pre-weaning growth, ewe milking ability and carcass weight.

TSS Terminal survival. The economic value for lamb vigour at birth.

TSM Terminal meat. A function of meat yield.

TSD Terminal dag score. The propensity to carry dags.

TSF Terminal internal parasite resistance. Predicted from faecal egg counts (FEC) using the WormFEC system

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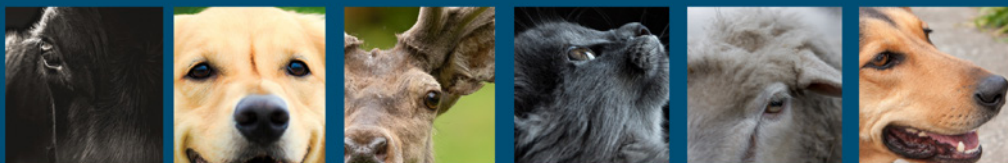

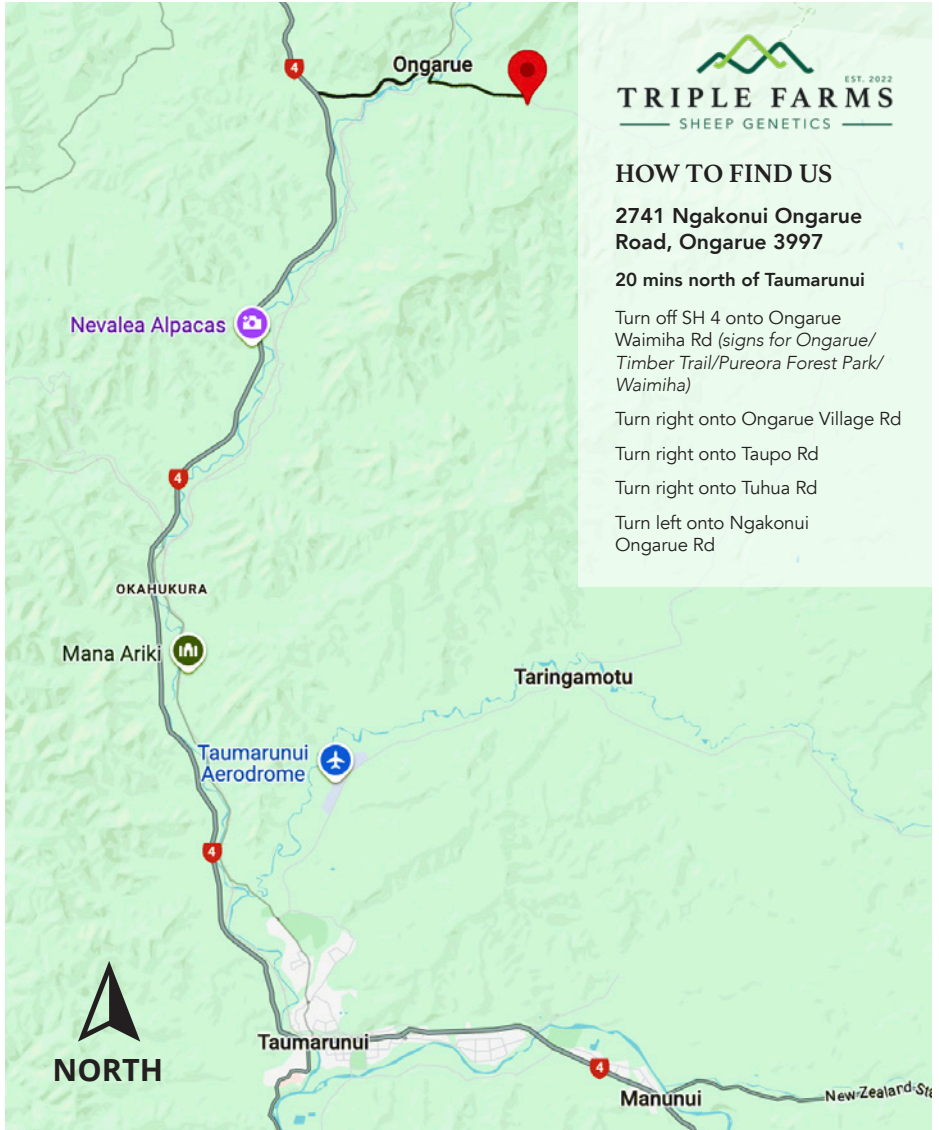
